AEI **FASTLINKS** was contracted by Rockefeller Group Technology Solutions, a large firm out of New York, NY to establish a series of dual-wireless connections between a eight of the Bronx Lebanon Hospital's facilities. For each connection, a 100Mbps FSO link was installed to provide a secure channel for their LAN traffic and a license-free radio link was installed to provide a backup connection for the LAN connection in the event of a hardware failure or weather related outage as well as a T1 side channel to support voice traffic. The implementation of the wireless network designed by **AEI** proved to be extremely cost effective in comparison to leased lines of like bandwidth.
