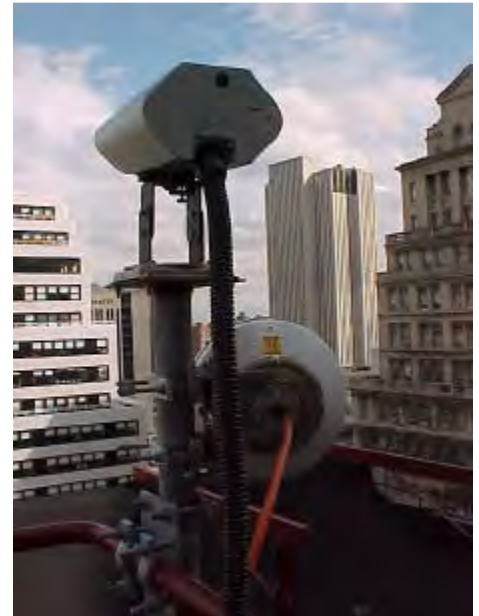


Application Profile: Pace University

AEI FASTLINKS was chosen to install a pair of wireless links between three of the University's facilities on its downtown Manhattan campus. One of the links was a 10/100BaseT (45Mbps, full duplex capable) + 2T1 channel unlicensed radio (RF) link, which provided LAN & voice connectivity to one of the University's dorms. The other link, a 100BaseT (100Mbps, full duplex capable) free space optic (FSO) link was installed to provide redundancy for the LAN traffic between the main campus LAN, the dorm and another building that housed administrative offices. Wireless was by far the most cost-effective solution for establishing connectivity in that getting the right of way to run conduit under the city streets was not possible.
