

## **Application Profile: UCLA Medical Center**

**AEI** FASTLINKS was chosen by UCLA to design and install a cost-effective, high bandwidth wireless link to provide an alternative medium backup to the 1000baseT fiber optic connection in place between the UCLA Medical Center campus and the Santa Monica Hospital. In order to keep cost down and span the distance of 3.3 miles between the sites, FastLinks recommended the installation of a Proxim Tsunami 480 radio link. The dual band radio was easily installed and made operational.
